1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Kara Guimmo called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. CITIZENS COMMENTS

3. APPROVAL OF THE MEETING MINUTES

Krol offered a motion, seconded by Burrows, to approve an administrative change to the May 7, 2020 meeting minutes clarifying that the motion refers to a side yard setback of .29 feet for a total setback of 5.81 feet. There was a roll call vote.

6. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Z 20-05: 271 S. Main – windows facing interior lot line in a side yard setback

Joe Phillips gave background on the history of the building and described the requested variance. Brian Langlois, representing Growth Works, said construction is likely to begin in the spring.

Citizens Comments

There were no citizen comments.

Board Discussion

The board discussed how the project might impact the future use of the adjacent parking lot and that the placement of the building on the lot presents a hardship.

Elliott offered a motion, seconded by Burrows, to approve request Z-20-05 to allow up to six new windows facing the interior lot line in the side yard setback.

Finding of facts:

There are already windows on the structure facing south, and this variance request does not increase existing non-conformance.

The existing siting of the building creates a nonconformity that constitutes a hardship.

Two rear windows improve fire egress conditions.

There was a roll call vote.
